



Lodi Police Foundation Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a student who exemplifies the highest degree of integrity and professionalism and who is dedicated to enhancing the City of Lodi community or the pursuance of a Law Enforcement Career.

Applicant Eligibility

The applicant for this scholarship must:

1. Be a resident of San Joaquin County;
2. Currently enrolled in no less than 6 units per semester; or have applied to/been accepted to a college or university following graduation;
3. Possess a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Scholarships

A total of up to three (3) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded each academic year.

Review of Application Scholarships

Lodi Police Foundation Scholarship

To be considered for the Lodi Police Foundation Scholarship, the following documentation must be submitted:

1. 1,000 word/2 page essay describing why you should be awarded the Lodi Police Foundation Scholarship;
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation from a non-relative;
3. An official Transcript from your current or most recent school;
4. A completed and signed application.
